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BESPOKE LIST OF GIN & TONICS



The “G&T” was introduced by the army of the British East India Company in India and other tropical climates. Malaria and a host of other diseases were of constant concern. In the late 1700’s it was discovered that quinine could both treat and even cure some of these including malaria. Officers in India in the early 19th century began adding a mixture of lime, water and sugar to their Gin rations and to the quinine to make the drink more palatable. Tonic water today contains much less quinine and is generally sweetened so a lot less bitter than the original.

INTERNATIONAL GINS

After its introduction in the UK in 1714, the consumption of Gin became so popular that London went through a period named “The Gin Craze”. It was said that the city had an epidemic of drunkenness from overconsumption of the liquor, so much so that in 1729 Parliament passed the first Gin Act, created control the consumption of the spirit.

GORDONS GIN

London, England

The behemoth of the industry needs no introduction, surely? Gordon's gin is one of the top 10-selling spirits in the world, and has been made to the same recipe since the late 18th century.

- **GORDONS PINK GIN**

London, England

Gordon's Pink is perfectly crafted to balance the refreshing taste of Gordon's with the natural sweetness of raspberries and strawberries, with the tang of redcurrant served up in a unique blushing tone.

BROKERS GIN

London, England

Brokers Gin is batch distilled using traditional botanicals such as juniper, coriander seed, cinnamon, cassia bark, liquorice, orris root, orange and lemon peel, angelica root and nutmeg. End result is a classic old school gin.

BLOOMSBURY LEMON

London, England

Lemon Gin, once a staple of the cocktail cabinet, enjoyed great popularity between the 1930s and 1990s and can be found in recipes from cocktail books of the time. Bloomsbury have now resurrected the product with a flavour which is very comparable to the original varieties, but with a higher proof, making it more mixable.

BOMBAY SAPPHIRE GIN

London, England

Juniper, coriander, angelica, almonds, cubeb berries, lemon peel, orris, liquorice, cassia bark and grains of paradise come together to form fresh and lively gin, lighter than classic London Dry's but with a warm peppery finish.

PLYMOUTH

Plymouth, England

From deep earthy notes to wonderfully fresh juniper and a lemony bite, Plymouth Gin Original's great depth of flavour is just one of the reasons it's truly unique.

GLENDALOUGH WILD BOTANTICAL GIN

6

Wicklow, Ireland

Glendalough Wild Botanical Gin brings you through the seasons with fresh Spring notes of pine, juniper and citrus. It's smooth and mellow at first, brings you through to Summer floral and Autumn fruits and then leads into wintery warm spice. A long and balanced gin, fresh with just enough spice to linger after.

ABLEFORTH'S BATHTUB GIN

6.2

Kent, England

Winner of Best Cask Gin at the World Gin Awards 2016, this tempting tippie from Ableforth's is a masterclass in spice. It takes all the distillery's typical vibrancy of orange zest and candied peel, vanilla and a whip-crack of coriander and enriches it with a thick and smooth buttery undertow. A touch of ripe red fruit and a whiff of fudge lift the end to a light, aromatic climax.

THE KING OF SOHO GIN

6.5

London, England

The brainchild of Howard Raymond as a tribute to his late father - 'The King of Soho', Paul Raymond. Twelve botanicals are used in the production, including coriander, grapefruit peel, angelica root and cassia

MUFF GIN*Donegal, Ireland*

Crafted with lemon, mandarin and rosemary as well as the more traditional gin botanicals. This is a crisp and aromatic gin with a smooth creamy side coming from the potatoes used to produce the base spirit.

GLENDALOUGH SEASONAL GIN*Wicklow, Ireland*

Each season Glendalough Distillery forage what grows at that time of year to make a batch with botanicals from that small, seasonal window. What they forage, as usual, goes into the still within hours of being picked in the wild. And what they end up with is as close to terroir as you can get with a spirit. A gin with a sense of both time and place.

SIX O'CLOCK GIN*Bristol, England*

6 O'Clock has big hints of orange, lemon citrus and hints of elderflower. The citrus and floral flavours make this gin fresh to taste and Summery. The bottle describes the gin as 'Strikingly Smooth'.

DINGLE GIN

7

Kerry, Ireland

Dingle Gin Co. use amongst other botanicals, rowan berry from the mountain ash trees, fuchsia, bog myrtle, hawthorn and heather for a taste of the Kerry landscape. It's a formula unknown elsewhere

HENDRICKS GIN

7

Girvan, Scotland

Infused with rose petals and cucumber as well as the normal botanicals, this is a must for all gin-lovers. In the summertime, Hendrick's makes a fantastically refreshing gin and tonic.

TANQUERAY GIN

7

London, England

Tanqueray London Dry Gin is the original product that was launched in 1830; its key botanicals are juniper, coriander, angelica root and liquorice.

SHORTCROSS GIN

7

Down, Northern Ireland

ShortCross is smooth with an exceptionally long aftertaste and finish. This is achieved through the use of fresh apples, elderberries and wild clover distilled with other botanicals including juniper, coriander, orange peel, lemon peel and cassia.

JAWBOX GIN

7

Belfast, Northern Ireland

Jawbox Classic Dry is a single-estate gin made at Echlinville distillery near Belfast. Made using 11 botanicals including heather, liquorice, cubeb and grains of paradise and is calculated, amongst other things, to create the sense of place and provenance.

GUNPOWDER GIN

7

Leitrim, Ireland

Drumshanbo Gunpowder Irish Gin is an oriental-inspired spirit from The Shed Distillery in Co Leitrim. Taking its name from one of the signature botanicals, slowly dried Gunpowder tea, the recipe also includes lime, lemon and grapefruit.

AVAIATION GIN

7

Oregon, USA

A new gin based on the fuller-bodied Dutch style with rye neutral grain spirit and a ‘botanical democracy’ of juniper, cardamom, coriander, lavender, anise, sarsaparilla and orange peel.

BROCKMANS GIN

7

London, England

Expect exquisite aromas of coriander, blueberry, blackberry and, of course, juniper. Unique style and very smooth. Botanicals are soaked in pure grain spirit for several hours before distillation.

AN DÚLAMÁN GIN

7.5

Donegal, Ireland

It is the very essence of Donegal and uniquely captures the drama and magic of the sea. Sliabh Liag captures this by using five locally harvested seaweeds as well as six other botanicals. A beautifully well rounded gin with plentiful notes of the sea, soft juniper and a buttery sweetness.

BROOKLYN GIN

7.8

New York, U.S.A

Brooklyn is a handmade gin from New York. Distilled from local corn and using botanicals including citrus peels from locally grown fruit, this is fresh, complex and wonderful in a G&T.

FAIR OLD TOM GIN

8.5

Poitou-Charentes, France

Spicy and sweet rendition from the folks over at FAIR, this Old Tom's a smooth and subtle fellow full of fresh, fragrant vanilla and rich, floral honeysuckle. A heavy, satisfying mouth-feel plays host to a delightful aromatic sweetness soon joined and complemented by powerful juniper, a touch of cinnamon and a suggestion of citrus in a finish which comes all too soon.

NIKKA COFFEY GIN*Miyagikyo, Japan*

This gin has a silky texture and rich body. Its aromatic complexity relies on the delicate balance of various botanicals including Japanese citrus such as Yuzu, Kabosu and Amanatsu. There are a touch of apples, a fruit deeply related to the history of Nikka.

HIDDEN CURIOSITIES GIN*Surrey, England*

A funky gin made with 20 botanicals, including Japanese yuzu, pink grapefruit, bergamot, lavender and five different types of peppercorn. Garnish with peppercorns if you like your gin spicy, or with grapefruit peel to bring out the citrus notes.

MONKEY 47*Schwarzenberg, Germany*

A curious gin from the Black Forest in Germany. Made with 47 (yes, really) botanicals and bottled at 47%, they also use a 'secret weapon typical to the Black Forest' in the mix – cranberries.

NO.209 SAUVIGNON BLANC GIN*California, U.S.A*

One of a pair of barrel-aged gins from San Francisco's No.209, this was rested for three months in Rudd Sauvignon Blanc barrels, adding a white wine colour, along with buttery and fruity flavours.

WHISKEY

A beverage distilled from fermented grain mash, with different grains use din different varieties. Irish whiskey is generally distilled three times in pot still whiskey from a continuous still added. Irish whiskey is characteristically sweeter and not as peaty as its Scottish counterpart.

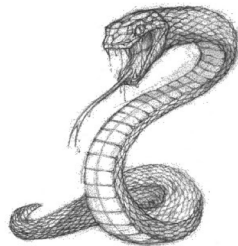

It has straw colour, sometimes intense. To the nose the bouquet is lasting and fruity, rich in sensations and persistent. The palate is dry, balanced and soft, thanks to its full body high acidity with flavours of green apple.

This seductive Sauvignon Blanc oozes gooseberry and passion fruit, with notes of ripe figs, lemon grass and capsicum. Following through is a delicious concentration of tropical fruit, nettles and cut grass flavours on the palate.

Albarino, Spain, 2017

This wine is refreshing, full of juicy peach, orange pith, and soft florals. Invitingly aromatic, it lingers in the palate but doesn't overstay it's welcome.

Attractive Chardonnay aromas of peach and nectarine, along with zesty grapefruit. Subtle creme caramel and creamy notes add a lovely touch of complexity.

Very aromatic. Normal bouquet of elderflower and nettles. Taste of tropical fruit, especially passion fruit. High acidity.

Chardonnay, France, 2014

Golden in color. Intense and elegant nose of peach, pear, pink grapefruit and almond. The palate is fresh, balanced and creamy with suker notes of cherry blossom and zest of citrus fruits.

Riesling, Chile, 2017

Crisp and fruity whites are dry, medium-dry or medium-sweet. They are typically crisply acidic, which balances their rich fruitiness. You can discern yellow plum, apple and peach notes in these wines. Crisp acids create a fresh finish, making these wines ideal for a variety of foods.

Sauvignon Blanc, Chile, 2014

Bright and crisp, this is a wine of great intensity and aromatic persistence. Citrus notes of grapefruit against a mineral background are enhanced by soft traces of green herbs. An expressive and amazing wine, the palate is fresh, elegant, balanced, juicy and delicate.

Sauvignon Blanc, France, 2015

White peach and citrus fruit aromas with good minerality and intense freshness. Citrus and green apple are the predominant flavours appearing on the palate.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile, 2015

This wine is a clear ruby color with the spicy, liquorice and blackcurrant aromas characteristic of the grape variety. The wine has a firm backbone with smooth, tightly knit fruit and tannins and long elegant aftertaste.

Shiraz, Cabernet, Australia, 2013

The aromas are of red berry fruits and spicy oak. The palate has generous sweet flavours of raspberry, spice, green olive and truffle that develop to a finish characterised by creamy coconut oak and soft lingering tannins. A fruit driven wine.

A charming medium to full-bodied wine with a deep ruby red colour. Displays ripe fruit and raspberries on the nose with mulberry fruit and juicy dark plum on the palate. Elegant tannins with a soft, fruity finish. Integrated oak aromas complement a well-balanced wine

BERINGER*Zinfandel, California, 2015*

A dark ruby color with an incredibly plush bouquet, this Zinfandel shows beautifully in the glass. Raspberries, blueberries and deep notes of black cherry dominate this wine's aromas. Warming spices of white pepper, cinnamon and vanilla on the nose inform what the first sip of the wine will bring. On the palate, a burst of fruit gives way to the baking spices on the finish.

PASSO DOBLE*Malbec & Corvina, Argentina, 2015*

Deep dark red with violet edges. Firm and full bodied on the nose; the Malbec character comes through with its fruit and balsamic herb complexity. The palate accurately reflects this nose, and displays flavours of plums and fruits of the forest. Tannins are plentiful but extremely elegant. The finish has attractive cherry tastes, typically Veneto in style.

ANDEAN VINEYARDS RESERVA

Malbec, Argentina, 2016

An impressive Malbec with deep purple hues and concentrated fruit notes like blackberry and red currant. The nose shows purity of fruit and complexity of aromas of a Malbec. It is a wine with an exquisite mouth and very sweet tannins and a long silky finish.

MONOLOGO CRIANZA

Rioja, Spain, 2015

Made with 100% Tempranillo grapes, Monologo Crianza is an approachable oak-aged Rioja with aromas of ripe red fruit, liquorice and vanilla. Garnet red in colour, it is aged for 12 months in American oak barrels. On the mouth it is refreshing and balanced, with pleasant tannin notes, the oak is just a little more dominant than the fruit.

FOUNDERS BLOCK

Cabernet Sauvignon, Australia, 2014

The generously structured palate shows rich fruit and light oak flavours. Ripe dark berries, plum and dusty mulberry with a hint of regional mint character are highlights within the lush palate. Fine grained and soft tannins add to the lingering and attractive finish.

Pinot Noir, Chile, 2014

There is a lot going on here: smoky, charred notes intermingle with ripe cherries, plums and sweet spices. Strawberry, blackberry and gooseberry flavours with a silky texture and tannins that feel tight, adding grip and persistence.

LOUIS JADOT FLEURIE

Gamay, France, 2015

This red is soft and fragrant, with notes of red currants, raspberry and strawberry and a hint of banana. The palate is ripe and rich with red fruit dominating with a little spice, great acidity and good minerality to compliment.

MARQUES DE RISCAL RESERVA

Rioja, Spain, 2014

Very expressive aromas on the nose with notes of liquorice, cinnamon and black pepper, with just a subtle hint of the long cask-ageing, thanks to its great complexity and ripe, concentrated fruit. Fresh and easy to drink on the palate, good backbone and lovely, polished tannins. The long, persistent finish leaves gentle balsamic reminders of the finest quality.

FOUNDERS BLOCK

Shiraz, Australia, 2012

A generous Coonawarra Shiraz, brimming with spicy and red fruit flavours coupled with gentle oak flavours of sweet vanilla add complexity and depth. A batch of this wine was matured in American and French oak, imparting firm structure as a young wine, and ageability over the medium term.

KATNOOK ESTATE

Merlot, Australia, 2010

It doesn't hold back on the dark, ripe fruit, so be ready for a mouthful of forest berries from the very first sip. There's a lovely, subtle sweetness from all that fruit which makes it so enjoyable and approachable. There's also a little bit of warm oak and a velvety-ness that is comforting and warming.

GIGONDAS CHAPOUTIER

Grenache, Cinsault, Shiraz & Mourvèdre, France, 2016

Pronounced, developed nose of warm spicy fruits - blackberries and damsons - with a whiff of white pepper and cedarwood. Dry with firm tannin structure, lots of heat evident but huge weight of autumn berries fruits coming through.

MARQUES DE RISCAL GRAN RESERVA

Rioja, Spain, 2007

This wine coats the mouth with elegant flavours, creamy toasted notes and fruit arômas at the attack. It has a silky texture. A balanced wine with a good structure and an excellent acidity. It has well-integrated tannins and a long and very persistent finish. A very elegant great classic wine.

MASI AMERONE

Corvina, Rodinella, Molinara, Italy, 2012

Subtle and reserved aromas of mossy and raisin fruit. Delicious and complex on the palate with a graphite minerality from the single vineyard's soil underpinning the dried cherry fruit with herbal sage notes. Full-bodied with a spicy paprika finish.
